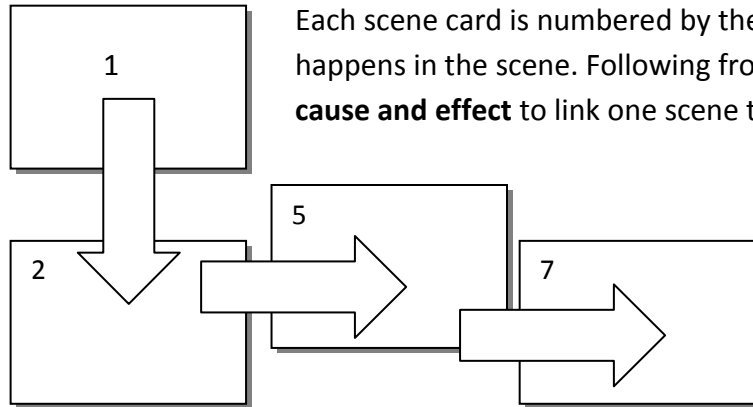


TOP HALF OF PAGE IS FOR THE ANTAGONIST'S PLOTLINE



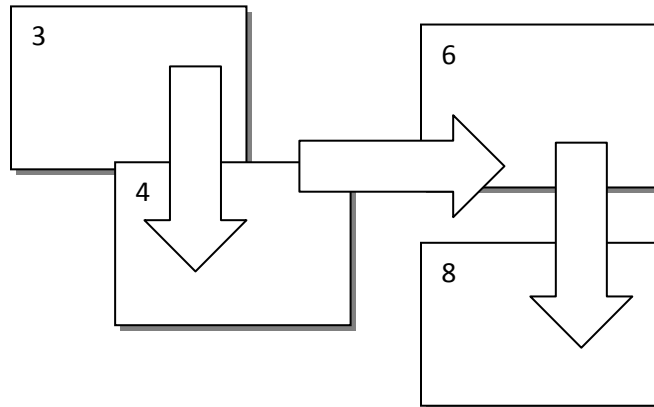
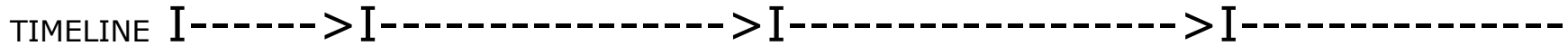
Each scene card is numbered by the order in which it appears in the story and tells in one sentence what happens in the scene. Following from top to bottom, left to right along the timeline, each scene must relate by **cause and effect** to link one scene to the next scene along the timeline.

Inciting Incident
(January)

Plot Point 1
(February)

midpoint
(early March)

Climax
(late March)



The midpoint of the story should take place as close as possible to the middle page of the book, such as 40,000 words into an 80,000 word book. First plot point, or turning point should land near 20,000 words. And Climax scene at beginning of last quarter of the book.
